Recently I took a 93 year old lady I know out for dinner and we went to Allen's restaurant and Allen gave us everything for free and was full of kind words and attention for this lady. Allen could tell she needed a friend and he made her feel like a Queen.

Allen struggled with ups and downs like we all do.

I’ve often believed his sensitive nature made life harder for him than many people. But he never gave up. He always pushed forward.

And he always was working on himself.

In another age or time , Allen would have been greatly admired and

appreciated for his many noble qualities. But such is not the age in which we currently live.

Allen married Lienda recently and loved her very much. Allen loved her children.

I often took my 9 year old son Robert with me to visit with Allen and Allen would just become a big kid and play with him and talk to him like he was an adult.

My son was crazy about Allen Rader.

To be so loving to animals , and to inspire the love of children, I don't know what more in the ways of character you could ask of a man.

Despite his setbacks and despite whatever life threw at him , he never ever gave up , and he was a true , loyal , and honorable friend.

I don't know what more I could say on behalf of man , or what other praise I could give that would be higher than that which I would give to Allen Rader.

He will always be in my heart , the heart of my son , and in the hearts of so many others who were lucky enough to have crossed paths with this unique and noble soul.

I will always love you Allen. And we will meet again.

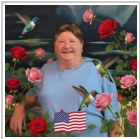
