Dr. Mack McElwain passed away on March 5, 2026, at Baptist Memorial Hospital–Union County at the age of 78. He was born on April 1, 1947, to the late Lee McElwain and Icy Reed McElwain.

Mack proudly served his country as a member of the United States Armed Forces. He was married to his beloved wife, Jane Cross McElwain, with whom he shared many cherished years.
