



Fred Hugh Lowery

Fred Hugh Lowery, 94, passed away January 8, 2026, at his home in Wesson, Mississippi. He was born November 26, 1931, in Amite, Louisiana, the son of Clyde Edwin Lowery and Tillie Bell Branton Lowery.

Fred, lovingly known by many as "Dude," graduated from Copiah-Lincoln Junior College in Wesson. He served in the U.S. Navy during the Korean War. In 1955, Fred married Josephine McMillin. Fred and Josephine would have three children. Fred worked as a meteorologist for the National Weather Service from 1955 until his retirement in 1986, working at Mobile, Alabama, during both Hurricanes Camille and Frederick. After the loss of his first wife, he later married Gladys Weimer.

Fred enjoyed fishing, hunting, playing dominoes, and also playing golf in his younger years. He was a die-hard Ole Miss fan.

Fred was preceded in death by his parents, his brother Hascal Lowery, and his first and second wife.
