Starkville, Mississippi---Mr. Hiram Guy Estes 91, formerly of Ripley, Mississippi passed at the Oktibbeha Regional Hospital in Starkville, MS on Thursday February 10, 2011 after a brief illness. Mr. Estes was born August 19, 1919 in Tippah County, the third of twelve children born to Lee and Elizabeth Shappley Estes. He married Edith Reed of Falkner on October 17, 1947 in Tippah County. Mr. Estes had numerous occupations including logger, farmer, stoerkeeper, carpenter and painter. He enjoyed reading the daily newspaper, attending high school basketball games, listening to country music, gardening, traveling, and visiting with family and friends. He was one of the founding members of the Child Haven School of Ripley for special education students and assisted in many fund raising events for its operation.
