“ Jerry, Maryann and family:

I cannot begin to describe the shock and sadness Mother and I felt when we learned of Scott's fatal accident.

Bits and pieces of memories of scenes from Scott as a young child, and then memories of his children as babies and young children kept flashing through my mind.

I see Scott and several of the children his age playing "professional wrestling in a ring they had made near our back yard. My brother was the referee.

I see Scott as a young father, and his first child (Mindy) the day he brought her home from the hospital. I went out to see the baby as soon as they arrived home. She was wrapped in a blanket on that cold day, and he unwrapped the blanket from her face to show her to us. Such a tall, proud young father--holding such a tiny baby.

I see Kelly when we saw her as a baby.

I see Dylan--not as a baby, but as a toddler, visiting with my brother in our yard, asking for Juicy Fruit Chewing gum. He would ask for gum, saying "Gum, We, We," since he could not pronounce his name. My brother kept the chewing gum for all the children, who visited him, especially Scott's children, since they were our closest neighbors at that time.

I see Abby, as a baby--I thought she was a doll the first time I saw her. Such a perfect little doll. The first children, now young adults--each different--each special in their own way.

I did not see Scott much during his later adulthood. He worked different hours, but when I did, he always called me Ma'am. And I thought--How can it be that this big man whom I saw as a child called me Ma'am? Where did the years go?

There is no shock as great as a sudden death, especially when a parent loses a child or a sibling loses a brother. I have experienced this in my own family.

I did not know that Scott's nickname was "Bigfoot." It could also have been "Big Heart," because through the years I could see evidence that he did indeed have a kind and generous heart.

May God bless you and comfort you as only He can. And may your own good memories of Scott bring you peace and comfort in the difficult days ahead. Words cannot heal--God can.
