Jamie Ellen Moody was born on August 1, 1967, in Ripley, Mississippi, to Morris and Mary Frances Moody. The youngest of five children, she completed the Moody family and was cherished by her parents and siblings.

Jamie grew up in Benton County, in the Abel's Store community—a place she deeply loved and called home for her entire life. She attended Gray Academy and graduated from Hickory Flat Attendance Center in 1986.

As a child, and even as an adult, you could often find her exploring, hunting, and fishing in the hills and bottoms in the area. In recent years, she developed a passion for photography, capturing special moments at weddings, showers, and graduations, as well as the beauty of nature.
