At his request, there is no service.

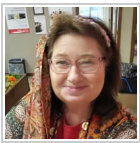

Watch over us, lil bro. 🙏.

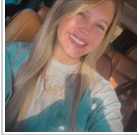

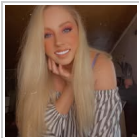

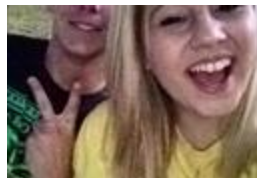
