HUNT, Kenneth Lloyd, 78, of Brooksville, FL and from Bragg City, MO passed away Thursday, March 21, 2019 at the Sturgill Hospice Care Center in Brooksville after a battle with pneumonia and lung and heart complications. Kenny, as he was known to friends and family, was born February 25, 1941 to the late William C. and Allie (King) Hunt.
