Larry Allen Murphy passed away on January 4, 2025, at his residence in Ripley, Mississippi, at the age of 59. He was born in Ripley to James Allen Murphy and Martha Ann Duncan Murphy.

Allen furthered his education at Northeast Mississippi Community College, where he completed two years of study and earned his associate's degree. He was self-employed with Murphy Quality Blasting, a trade in which he was well known for his skill and dedication.
