Blue Mountain, MS - Leroy Tate "Butch" Coombs, 81, passed away Friday, January 1, 2021, at his home in Blue Mountain, MS. He was born on December 25, 1939, to Thomas Leroy and Maddie Bennett Coombs, in Tippah County - Mississippi. Butch graduated from Blue Mountain High School in 1957 and attended Northeast Mississippi Community College. Following school, he began what would become a lifelong career in the propane industry.

Through hard work and perseverance, he built the business into a people focused company that today serves thousands of families and businesses across Mississippi and Tennessee.

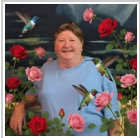
