Marty Nichole Duncan Calderon, 38, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, June 25, 2025, surrounded by her family and loved ones in her home in Fort Worth, Texas. As her best friend prayed beside her and her family surrounded her, Marty was lovingly ushered into heaven.
