Randy F. Johnson was born 73 years ago to Att Johnson Jr. and Willena Evans Johnson in Fulton, MS. He graduated from IAHS, Itawamba Community College, and Mississippi State University with honors.

He was employed by Genesco Inc. a total of 45 ½ years. Forty-four of those years he worked in many capacities, from factory assistant manager to his final job as Director of Global Sourcing (Johnston and Murphy division), which took him to many countries. After his retirement, Genesco hired him as a private consultant in which he worked for one and half years.

Randy is survived by his wife Jamie of Blue Mountain, MS, two sons, Scott (Neva) Johnson of Jacksonville, FL, Brad (Angie) Johnson of Thompson's Station, TN, three grandsons, three granddaughters, two brothers, Hal Johnson of Mooreville, MS, and Reggie (Debbie) Johnson of Fulton, MS.
