Thomas Henry Lewis, 89, of Olive Branch, MS was taken to be with the Lord and Savior on April 1, 2023. Thomas was born on June 30, 1933 in Clarkdale, AR. In 1950, Thomas married the love of his life, Evelyn Eloise Lewis, of Joiner, AR. Thomas and Evelyn started their life together in Memphis, TN. After the birth of their oldest son, Dennis G. Lewis, they moved to Illinois where Thomas worked at Stoner Manufacturing as a machinist for several years. After several years in the Chicago area, they had their second son, Thomas D. Lewis. In 1963, they moved back to Memphis and their youngest son, Rodney S. Lewis, was born in 1967. He later retired from the Memphis Publishing Company as a refrigeration engineer in 1995 at the young age of 62.

Thomas served as Secretary/Treasurer of Frayser United Pentecostal Church for over 20 years as well as teaching Sunday School and numerous other volunteer duties within the church. Thomas and Evelyn lived in Ripley, MS for a short time and attended Blue Mountain Church of the Lord Jesus Christ. For the last 19 years, Thomas was a member of the Bethel United Apostolic Church. Thomas was a man of great faith, he loved his Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ. Throughout his life, he kept Christ in the center along with his wife and family. He loved volunteering his time at the church doing whatever needed to be done.

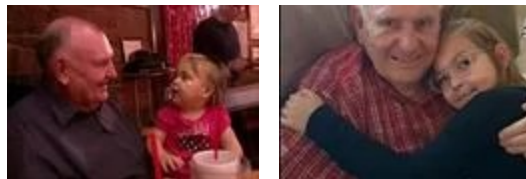
