New Albany, MS - William Clifton "Cliff" Pannell, passed away Friday, December 18, 2020, at North Mississippi Medical Center in Tupelo. He was born on February 27, 1946, to William Olen and Emily Doris Goudelock Pannell in New Albany, MS. He was a retired engineer for Standex-Master-Bilt Corp after 39 years of service. Cliff had decades of service to the Boy Scouts of America as Scoutmaster. He also served as a trainer for new scout leaders and earned the highest award in Scouting - The Silver Beaver. He was a faithful member and Deacon at First Baptist Church in New Albany for many years and also a Greeter. He was a graduate of New Albany High School and Mississippi State university.
