



William Terry McCluskey

William Terry McCluskey, 73, passed away peacefully at his home February 13, Monday. Terry was born July 1, 1949 to Albert Anderson McCluskey and Naomi Carnal McCluskey. Terry was a lifelong faithful, dedicated member of the New Prospect Presbyterian Church. He loved the Lord and loved serving the church. Terry was usually the first one to arrive at church and he always had a smile to greet everyone who arrived. Terry was a faithful member of the Sunday School Class, and he was always in his pew for Sunday Morning Worship. He drove the Church Van, served as a Deacon, and for many years cut the Church lawns. Terry's absence at church was such an exception, if he wasn't present and hadn't notified anyone ahead of time, someone went to check on him. Terry was also a consistent faithful member of a community of breakfast club where he was also one of the first to arrive at 5am. For many years before the pandemic they gathered at McDonalds but later the group moved to the new Jack's Restaurant. The group knew if Terry wasn't present and hadn't let them know, one or two would go to his home. Terry was a house painter and did some carpentry work. In addition to cutting the Church lawns, he was the Yard Man for many in the community. He also loved country music and played his own drum set with a few of his friends' bands for almost 40 years. He loved watching TV Westerns, especially Gunsmoke, and had a large collection of the old TV Western movies he also enjoyed in his childhood.

Terry is survived by one brother, Jimmy Dow McCluskey, his sister-in-law, Doris Freeman McCluskey; one niece, Larie McCluskey Coleman, and one great-niece Emily Katherine Coleman, all of Waco, TX.

He is preceded in death by his parents.
